The works embody the narratives of being lost and the perpetual search by struggling to find a common ground between the masculine and the feminine; suburbia and escapism; minimalist ideology and the decorative. Through combining materials such as oil paint, the act of stitching and other media, the works seek to explore the symptoms and products of the collision of these dichotomies.
