The majority of works appearing in this exhibition were painted at Nyinyilki a remote outstation on Bentinck Island. Painting 'in' country during the dry season has enabled Netta to form a body of work which is diverse and colourful. Her paintings portray a personal geometry of forms that represent places and country akin to the artist and her family.
