Ikuntji, Haasts Bluff was the second Lutheran Mission established after Hermannsburg, where a few small family groups from Pitunbi country to the west "came in" to sit down at the eastern end of their songline. Situated about 250km NW of Alice Springs, Hermannsburg is to the south and Papunya to the north. In 1994 women of the Ikuntji Womens Centre embarked on a historical painting project with senior women living in Kintore, which created a premise in the western desert for female painters to embark on their own careers. Their influences range from the figurativism of Namitijira and his sons to the Papunya movement of the early 1970's. Ikuntji artists forge high-keyed works from robust palettes, informing audiences through a direct and confident approach to the canvas and a diverse range of painting techniques.
