Working with motifs and devices drawn from cybernetic culture, my recent body of work investigates problems of the feminised body, queer theory and transgender representations in technosexual imagery. Resultantly, these representations perpetuate issues of immobility, subservience and sexual manipulation.

Through the use of photography and self-portraiture, I manipulate my own figure as the subject of such representations positioning myself within the circulation of these images while simultaneously providing a critique of their cultural and technical conventions. This body of work oscillates between an introspective reflection on my own physicality and an outward statement challenging heteronormative dogma evident in technosexualised imagery.
