"Risk" brings together the work of Robert (Bob) Gant and his niece Lezah Gant-Gildea, as they address their concern with the impact of climate.

Bob's artwork reveals the long-term impact of harsh climate on early homesteads across the country.

These structures are an important part of our heritage but they are at such risk of gradual degradation and eventual collapse from extreme weather conditions. Using pencil on paper, Bob captures the unyielding Australian landscape.

Lezah addresses the risk of pollution and climate change to the Great Barrier Reef. Sediment runoff, tourist damage and global warming harm the Reef. Through abstract, figurative and pop art in acrylic and oil, Lezah highlights these concerns, showcasing diverse styles being her less usual but conscious choice!

Lezah is nearing completion of her Degree of Fine Arts at Queensland College of Art, Griffith University and looking forward to future exhibitions. For Bob, however, "Risk" will be his final exhibition as Bob, now in his eighties, suffers from macular degeneration resulting in severe eye-sight loss. "Risk" then is a special opportunity for Bob and Lezah to share in exhibiting together.
