They have been kept away for a while; they step warily into the world of light.


Each side of a symmetrical thing explains the other, the way a mirror explains the mirrored, without being the same; there is a kind of symmetry between the image and the one looking at it.


Many artists I know live on islands. I also live on an island; Islands are aware of continents in a way that continents are not aware of islands.


