And I enjoy drawing and painting them.

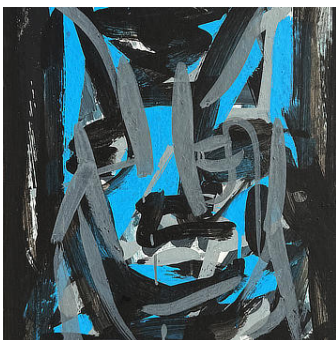
